Affiliates	<ul> <li>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</li> <li>Our affiliates include RoundPoint Mortgage Servicing Corporation and RoundPoint Mortgage Solutions, LLC or companies with RoundPoint in their name.</li> </ul>
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Nonaffiliates we share with can include mortgage companies, insurance companies, securities firms, financial advisors, tax preparers, retailers, direct marketing companies and nonprofit organizations.</li> </ul>
Joint marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Our marketing partners include insurance and other financial companies.</li> </ul>
